

CALL FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DISSEMINATION ACTIVITIES IN FRANCE IN THE FRAME OF THE “PV-PROSUMER 4 GRID” PROJECT

Object:

The Becquerel Institute is looking for a subcontractor for dissemination activities in France in the framework of the European project PV-Prosumers4Grid.

The PV-Prosumers4Grid project:

This Horizon 2020 project aims to develop and implement innovative self-consumption and aggregation concepts and business models for PV prosumers. Eventually, these will help integrating sustainable and competitive electricity from PV in the European electricity system.

Role of the subcontractor:

The subcontractor will be in charge of promoting the PVP4Grid project’s results by targeting the national policy-makers and regulatory bodies as well as final consumers and market stakeholders, such as housing associations, user cooperatives, consumer associations, PV and renewable industry associations and networks, environmental associations and NGOs. This will allow the replication and support of the suggested business models.

In particular, the subcontracting company or organization should take care of the organization of three national workshops or bilateral meetings in France, with French policy-makers and regulatory bodies in order to inform them about the project outcomes and generate commitment to overcome the identified barriers and obstacles to their implementation.

Information about the workshops:

The workshops will take place from May 2018 until March 2020. The organization of each national workshop will have a budget of €1500.

Selection procedure:

The subcontractor should send a detailed offer, explaining how it will meet the criteria mentioned here below and what is its experience in organizing such event.

The subcontractor will be selected according to a general “value for money” evaluation. In particular, to determine which offer presents the best value for money, the following criteria will be taken into account:

- The price quote;
- The ability of the subcontractor to ensure the participation of a reasonable number of national stakeholders;
- The ability of the subcontractor to reach relevant stakeholders and ensure their participation to the workshop;
- The proven experience of the subcontractor in collaborating with key national stakeholders such as policy-makers and regulatory bodies;
- The expertise and knowledge of the subcontractor of the regulatory and economic questions related to PV prosumers.

Note that this list is not exhaustive. Other valuable arguments brought up by the candidates within their offer can be considered, despite not being listed here above.
